

# From “Just Listed” to “Sold” — Eight (8) Steps in the Life of a Single-Family Listing



**1**  
Enter your listing into Realcomp/RCO3® within **48 hours** of the listing contract being signed. Note: “**Personal information**” is not permitted in the public remarks.

**2**  
**Reach:** Your active listing is then automatically available to 14,700+ Realcomp REALTORS®, their 100,000+ clients through auto-emails generated by RCO3®, and thousands more REALTORS® through our Data Sharing arrangements.

**3**  
**Listing Syndication:** Depending on the instructions that are set by each DR®/Broker Owner, **your listing is then automatically distributed** to Realtor.com, MoveInMichigan.com, IDX websites, and more through our syndication program.



**4**  
**Photos:** Photos are to be uploaded to the listing **within Seven (7) Days** of the entry date. An **exterior view** must be used for the primary photo.

**5**  
**Documents/Disclosures:** Listing disclosures are to be uploaded to the listing by the listing agent (or office) **within Ten (10) days of the entry date**. Online document access is required.

**6**  
**ShowingTime™ Showing Requests:**  
Be sure to setup your listing for online showing requests through RCO3®/ ShowingTime™ application.



**7**  
**Pending:** Once a written offer has been accepted by the seller(s), the listing agent is required to **change the status to Pending within 48-hours**.

**8**  
 Once the property closes, the listing agent is required to **change the status to Sold within Five (5) Days**. Also, be sure to disable any auto-email(s) you may have setup for that client.

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## Important Notes:

- **The Days on Market (DOM)** calculation is based on the number of days that occur from the list date to the first day the listing is taken off-market. If re-listed within 30 days, the DOM calculation continues.
- **The listing will stay Active until** it is changed to another status or expires (at midnight) of the expiration date. **All active listings must be available for showings.** Once expired, a listing cannot be extended. It can always be relisted under another MLS number though.
- **At 120 days after the Pending date**, the MLS system will remind the listing agent to update the listing. This will occur at 180 days for Short Sale or New Construction listings.



## Listing Reminder Timeline for Listing Agents with Single-Family Listings

*Print and Use for Staying on Top of Listing Deadlines*



1) New listing entered into Realcomp/RCO3® **within 48 hours of contract signing.**

**MLS Policy Reminders:** Be sure to avoid including any personal information in the public remarks, photos, or virtual tours of the listing. Personal information consists of phone numbers, fax numbers, e-mail addresses, names, web URLs, open house model hours. **All active listings must be available for showings (with exception of auction listings which are not accessible).**



2) Listing photos uploaded to listing **within seven (7) days of the listing entry date.**

3) Online disclosures (and any other documents desired by the listing agent) uploaded to listing **within 10 days of the listing entry date.**

4) Be sure to setup your listing for online showing requests through RCO3®/ShowingTime™ application.

5) Once an offer has been accepted on the listing, update the status to Pending **within 48 hours of the offer being accepted.**

Note: If the listing status remains Pending for 120 days, listing agent must confirm the status as Pending with Realcomp every 30 days until the listing status is changed to Sold.

6) Once the listing closes, update the status to Sold **within five (5) days of the closing.**
